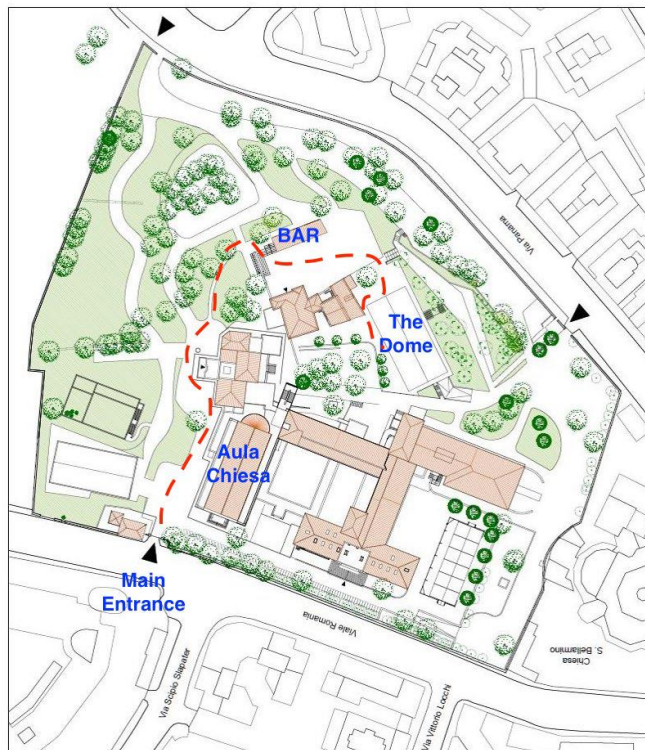
## OTHER PRACTICAL INFORMATION

## Getting to Rome

### By plane

Rome is served by two airports:

- Fiumicino (FCO), located 35 km from Luiss University, Viale Romania Campus
- Ciampino (CIA), located 20 km from Luiss University, Viale Romania Campus

### By train

The main train station is Roma Termini, located 5 km far from Luiss University, Viale Romania Campus.

National, regional and international trains and the Leonardo Express train to Fiumicino Airport leave from Roma Termini.

All shuttle companies offer connections every 30 minutes Monday to Sunday. Travel time is approximately 50 minutes. Tickets can be bought on board and online.

### By car

A1 ('Autostrada del Sole') runs from Milano to Napoli through Bologna, Firenze and Roma. Exit at 'Roma centro' to reach Luiss.

## Getting to Luiss University from Roma Termini train station

By taxi: Estimated taxi fare is €15

By bus: Bus 223 or 360 or 910 (about 25 minutes)

By car: Luiss is located in the Parioli area, in the northern part of the city. There are no traffic limitations in this area. Parking at Luiss is not permitted.

### Bus and Metro tickets

Rome has an integrated public transport network that includes metro, bus, tram and urban railway service. There are 3 metro lines: A, B and C. They circulate from 5.30am to 11.30pm. On Friday and Saturday, the service is extended until 1.30am.

Tickets must be bought before boarding the bus, metro or tram, and must be validated at the beginning of the journey. Passengers found without a valid ticket will have to pay a fine between € 50 and € 100.

## Taxi

To book a Taxi, call 06.3570. It is uncommon to hail a cab in the street. Instead, you generally need to wait at a designated taxi rank or book it in advance.

Taxi Apps are also available, such as Free Now, it Taxi, Wetaxi (and many others). These can sometimes be quicker and easier to use than the phone lines.

It is strongly recommended to specify if you want to pay by credit card, either while reserving the pick-up service or while getting into a taxi.

Please ensure you use a licensed taxi. These are painted white, have "taxi" lights on the roof, and have Comune di Roma decals (with the taxi's license number) on the doors.
