



11th ACE Annual Conference, 13 - 14 December 2013 Brussels, Belgium

Conference Venue is Université Libre de Bruxelles, 50 Avenue Franklin Roosevelt à 1050 Bruxelles – Building R42.

How to get to the conference venue

By public transport:

- From *Gare de Bruxelles-Centrale*: take the bus line 71 towards “Delta” and alight at the “ULB-Solbosch” stop. Walk from “ULB-Solbosch” stop to the conference venue.
- From *Gare de Bruxelles-Midi*: Take the metro line 2 towards “Simonis” and alight at “Porte de Namur” station. Then take the bus line 71 towards “Delta” and alight at the “ULB-Solbosch” stop. Walk from “ULB-Solbosch” stop to the conference venue.

Total travel time from Gare Bruxelles-Centrale et Gare de Bruxelles-Midi is about 30 - 40 minutes. A public transport ticket costs € 2.

From Brussels National airport

Take the train from the *Brussels National Airport* to *Gare de Bruxelles-Centrale* and take the bus line 71 as explain above.

Total travel time from Brussels national Airport is about 1 hour – 1 hour and 15 minutes

The conference dinner will be held at Hotel de Ville de Bruxelles – Salle Gothique/Salle des Mariages.

The easiest option by public transport to go there from the conference venue is: Take the bus line 71 towards “De Brouckère” and alight at “Gare Centrale”. Then walk to the Grand Place de Bruxelles following the signs placed along the streets.

Total travel time from Gare Bruxelles-Centrale to Grand Place (Hotel de Ville) is about 5 minutes.
