On June 12 2014 the General Court in Luxembourg will issue its long-awaited judgment on the Article 102 decision against Intel. This decision is likely to have important implications for the legal and economic treatment of loyalty rebates. It may also have a direct bearing on the future application of the European Commission's Guidance Paper on exclusionary conduct, and in particular on the use of price-cost tests. The ACE webinar will discuss the economic implications of the Intel judgment, with three economic experts in the area of loyalty discounts and foreclosure.
